

3120.05 - EMPLOYMENT OF PERSONNEL IN COMMUNITY EDUCATION PROGRAMS

The School Board recognizes that the success of community education programs depends in large measure upon the employment of qualified and competent personnel.

The Board shall fix the compensation and set the term of employment for each person employed in the subject programs established for this District. The Board will employ only those candidates recommended by the Superintendent.

A candidate's intentional misstatement of fact material to his/her qualifications for employment or the determination of his/her salary will be considered by the Board to constitute grounds for dismissal.

No candidate for employment shall receive recommendation for such employment without having proffered visual evidence of proper certification, if needed, or that application for such certification is in process.
